The number of job openings for IT professionals in Connecticut dropped in February. Employers posted a daily average of 720 opportunities last month. This is 7.7% less than in January.


Nevertheless, the slow growth trend in the state remains. Compared with February of last year the job market for technology skills is now 12.5% larger even with the drop last month. Hiring has picked up in recently which will lead to more advertised demand from employers. Expect more job postings this year.

Most industries had fewer job postings last month. Only employers in HiTech posted more. The national average increase 2.3% in February.

METHODOLOGY

SkillPROOF surveys the inventories of job openings at large, regional and nationwide direct employers. Job openings are counted and verified every 24 hours. All data sources have been verified for timely removal of filled or closed positions. No data from job boards or search firms are included.

For this report SkillPROOF estimates the counts of job openings. Estimates are calculated directly from SkillPROOF's actual daily counts of job openings. As a base for its calculations, SkillPROOF uses data and findings from reports of the Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS) http://www.bls.gov.
